The National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), working with the region's planning directors, has developed 5 alternative land use and transportation scenarios for the Washington region. In addition, the TPB has established a Scenarios Study Task Force to provide policy-level stewardship for the Scenarios Study. Staff will present the results of this work, including the development of 2 new scenarios, and Coalition members will recommend ways to establish linkages between the work of the TPB Scenarios Task Force and the Greater Washington 2050 Coalition.
