


Rate Options

LEAP is currently in the development phase with an expected launch date of January 2010. We welcome correspondence and will strive to answer inquiries as soon as possible, but have posted two of the most frequently asked questions below:

When I can I get my house done? LEAP's services will not be available until the program's launch. There are, however, energy auditor companies already in our community and contractors who can do the work. We suggest interested property owners inquire as to standards and certifications adhered to before contracting for work. BPI and HERS are the two most used certifications for auditors, and BPI is the national standard for home performance contracting. See our [residents](#) page for more information.



I'm a contractor and want to participate in this program - what do I need to do? We will put the word out through professional building organizations when we are ready to begin engaging the contracting community - namely the BRHBA, JRGBC, and AGCVA. [BPI](#) and [Home Performance with Energy Star](#) are key components of the residential program, so we do recommend you get acquainted with both.
