




Developing a Transportation Vision

Investment in E85

- 4 new public stations to open with the support of small State grants
- New Locations:
 - Rockville, Sunoco
 - Frederick, Chevron
 - Takoma Park, Texaco
 - Germantown, Chevron



Supporting Industry Growth Incentives for Ethanol

Renewable Fuels Promotion Act of 2005

20 cents/gallon from small grains

5 cents/gallon from corn

Developing Infrastructure State Government E85

- Existing station in Baltimore
- New station to open in Hanover, MD for the State Highway Administration
 - 5 more to be added
- Department of General Services to add 3 stations

Committing to E85

- State Government consumed 15,386 gallons (15 months)
- University of Maryland consumed 8,515 gallons (4 months)
