6. Nonroad Survey

A survey of non-road diesel equipments is being conducted in the region. In this study, information on types of non-road equipments that are used in road building, highway or related construction services will be collected. COG has contracted with NuStats, a research organization, to administer the survey. The subcommittee will discuss the potential emissions benefits from voluntary diesel retrofit program of non-road vehicles that could help conformity analysis.
