The Board directed the Metropolitan Development Policy Committee (MDPC) to develop a series of recommendations for how COG and the MDPC should best address the recommendations of the EGW advisory committee. During the July 11 meeting, an MDPC work group presented a draft proposal for a "Greater Washington 2050" initiative.
