

Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee March 15, 2007

1. Public Education and Outreach Programs

• *Air Quality Curriculum* – Piloting of the air quality curriculum continues and will be completed in May 2007.

2. Voluntary Business Emissions Reduction Campaign

• Auto Parts Washer Rebate Program – Montgomery County will be conducting a survey of roughly 150 auto repair facilities in the Anacostia watershed in March 2007. Input from the survey will be used to help design and implement the auto parts washer rebate program. Clean Air Partners will be meeting with representatives from Fairfax County, the District of Columbia, and the Baltimore region later this month to discuss interest in implementation in these areas.

3. Administration

- The Annual Meeting will be held on May 10, 2007 (12:00-2:00 pm) at the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) to approve the FY 2008 Work Program and Budget.
- Planning is underway for the 10-Year Anniversary signature event on June 5, 2007 (3:00-5:00 pm) to reaffirm the commitment between COG and the Baltimore Metropolitan Council.
