The National Capital Region is anticipated to grow in the next decade and the National Capital Planning Commission (NCPC) is interested in compiling an inventory of Park & Open Space land to examine if the region has sufficient "Green Infrastructure" to accommodate future populations. As part of this inventory NCPC will also examine and identify any potential federal sites, if surplus or closed through the BRAC process, which may serve a critical open space need. An initial step in the development of this inventory has been the creation of a draft trails map. This draft GIS map depicts the location and surface types of off-road trails in the National Capital Region. NCPC is presenting this working draft map to COG for their review and would appreciate the correction of any errors and the addition of any off-road trails that may have been missed.
