Item 13 is a notice item in which Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) has requested an amendment to the 2006 CLRP and FY 2007-2012 TIP to include construction of an interchange at US 340 and Jefferson Technology Park in Frederick. The draft scope of work for an air quality conformity assessment for this amendment is completed. These materials were released for public comment at the April 12 CAC meeting. The public comment period for these materials will close on May 12. The Board will be asked to approve the conformity work scope and schedule for this amendment at its May 16 meeting.

The TPB released the draft 2007 Financially Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (CLRP), the draft FY2008-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and the draft air quality conformity determination on December 13, 2007 at the TPB Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) for a 30-day public comment period which ends on January 12, 2008. The CLRP, TIP and air quality conformity assessment are scheduled to be approved at the January 16, 2008 TPB meeting

The CLRP includes road, bridge, high-occupancy vehicle (HOV), transit, bicycle and pedestrian projects funded through the year 2030. Four new projects and three studies are proposed for the 2007 CLRP. The six-year TIP includes all projects, programs, and strategies eligible for implementation between 2008 and 2013. The air quality conformity analysis assesses how the projects in the Plan and TIP, taken collectively, contribute to air quality improvement goals for the region.

Purpose. In coordination with the City of Alexandria and the Counties of Arlington and Fairfax, WMATA staff has developed a service plan that restructures Bus Lines 25A, F, G, J, P, R Ballston-Bradlee-Pentagon that operates six routes from Ballston to Pentagon and 7B, C, D, P, Lincolinia-North Fairlington that operates five routes from Pentagon to Southern Towers. These lines are being proposed for restructuring to simplify and rationalize the route structure, eliminate unproductive segments, and match demand with the appropriate level of service.

Proposal. The proposed service plan: 1) reallocates existing regional resources and reduces the annual operating regional subsidy; 2) reduces service on the 7 Line in the City of Alexandria; 3) adds service on the 25 Line in Arlington and Fairfax Counties and the City of Alexandria; 4) maintains service to existing passengers and improves service reliability; and 5) establishes Saturday service on non-regional route 22B in Arlington County.

Detailed information on the proposed restructuring and new service will be provided in area libraries, on Metrobuses, and at www.wmata.com/about/community.

All organizations or individuals desiring to be heard with respect to the proposed service changes will be afforded the opportunity to present their views, make supporting statements and offer alternative proposals. The air quality conformity analysis assesses the plan amendments and program with respect to the air quality requirements under the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments.
