Background

- Continuation of Metro's successful paratransit alternatives initiative.
- MetroAccess Eligibility is required.
- Subsidize a portion of trip costs of customers when using Regency Taxi or Silver Cab for trips that begin and end in Maryland.
- Possible expansion to all jurisdictions coming later.



Abilities-Ride Program Outline

- Decision to use services under this program is totally up to the customer
- Decision to use these services will not impact a customer's
 - paratransit eligibility, or
 - right to schedule MetroAccess trips
- None of the vehicles used are owned or operated by Metro



Customer Amenities

- Same-day Service
- Direct trips (non shared-ride service)
- Trip reservations can be made by telephone, mobile app or website
- Metro fare subsidy of up to \$15 per trip
 - Customer pays the first \$5 of fare and any fare above \$20



Accessibility

- Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles.
- Mobile Apps certified as 508 and Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0 (WCAG) Compliant

Drivers:

- required to accept all customers traveling with service animals
- required to have training related to serving customers with disabilities
- required to pass state level mandatory background checks.
