



Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) for the COG Region 2001 – 2021 (Annual Averages)




Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Projections 2020 to 2050 (Without Adjustment for Self-Employed and Military)






Round 10 Econometric Model Projections Employment Growth By 5-Year Interval (February 2022 vs. June 2022)





Comparison of Regional Employment Forecasts: Round 9 (June 2015) and Econometric Projections (February 2022 and June 2022)






Comparison of Regional Employment Forecasts by Year, 2015 to 2050 Round 9 (June 2015) February 2022 and June 2022






Comparison of Regional Employment Forecasts by Year, 2015 to 2030 S&P Global: June 2015 (Round 9), February 2022 and June 2022






Draft COG Round 10 Econometric Model Employment Forecast: Self-Employed + Military Added








Comparison of Regional Econometric Model: Regional Population Forecasts for 2020 to 2050 (February 2022 and June 2022)






Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Forecast Population Growth By 5-Year Interval (February 2022 vs. June 2022)








Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Population Forecasts Round 9 (June 2015) and Regional Econometric Model (February 2022 and June 2022)










Total Housing Units Authorized by Building Permits by Year In the COG Region







Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Projections 2020 to 2050 (February 2022 and June 2022)






Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Projections Households Growth By 5-Year Interval (February 2022 vs. June 2022)










Comparison of Regional Econometric Model Projections Household Forecasts Round 9 (June 2015) (February 2022 and June 2022)





Comparison of Regional Household Forecasts: Round 9.2 and Regional Econometric Model








ICF Estimate of Regional Employment Change due to COVID (000s)
