The Draft Revised Agreement

On July 1, 2025, the Chesapeake Bay Program released a draft revised version of the *Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement*, a roadmap for a restored Chesapeake Bay watershed signed by the governors of the six watershed states, mayor of Washington, D.C., administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of the federal government and the chair of the tri-state legislative Chesapeake Bay Commission in 2014. Based on extensive research and community input, the current *Watershed Agreement's* 10 goals and 31 outcomes have been consolidated, updated or revised for a proposed four goals and 21 outcomes.
