


Executive Committee Charge


 As part of Phase 2 of the Beyond 2025 effort, the Executive Council charged the Principals' Staff Committee (PSC) to complete "[r]evisions to the 2014 Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement (Agreement) with modifications to the existing vision, principles, preamble, goals, and outcomes...", and to do so by **December 1**st, **2025**. To address this charge, the Chesapeake Bay Program (CBP) modified its Strategy Review System (SRS) process for Workgroups (WGs) and Goal Implementation Teams (GITs) to answer an overarching question ("Big Question") as means to provide advice to the Management Board (MB) on the next step to take with each Agreement Outcome.




Recap

- Phase 2 will involve an assessment of all goals and outcomes, and recommendations on changes to the Partnership's structure
