- 3. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THREE RESOLUTIONS TO AMEND THE FY 2023-2026 TIP THAT MEET OR ARE EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT

### Actions:

 Adopt TPB SR7-2026 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 23-672 which adds \$874 million in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program funding to the Statewide Ridesharing Program (T3760), as requested by MDOT on behalf of the Maryland Transit Administration.

- Adopt TPB SR8-2026 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 23-67.3 which adds a net total of approximately \$37million in federal, state, regional, and local funding for the three projects listed below and described in the attached materials, as requested by VDOT.
  - Richmond Highway Corridor Improvements (T6443) add \$9.5 million in Surface Transportation Block Program (STBG), Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA), Revenue Sharing (REVSH), state, and local funding.
  - Route 7/Route 690 Interchange (TIP IDT6618) add \$9.4 million in National Highway Performance Program (NHPP), STBG, and state funding
  - o Northstar Boulevard Extension (T6687) add \$18.2 million in NVTA and REVSH funding
- Adopt TPB SR9-2026 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 23-67.3 which adds approximately \$15.3 million in federal, state, and local funding for the four programs listed below and described in the attached materials, as requested by VDRPT
  - PRTC Bus Acquisition / Replacement Program (T4506) add \$6.1 million in Urbanized Area Formula Funding (§ 5307), Bus and Bus Facilities Program funding (§ 5339), state, and local funding
  - o PRTC Bus Shelter Program (T5304) add program to TIP with \$212,403 in CMAQ and state funding
  - o PRTC Preventive Maintenance (T5601) add \$6.4 million in § 5307 and local funding
  - OMNIRIDE Express Commuter Bus Replacement (T6630) add \$2.8 million in CMAQ and state funding
