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COG BACKGROUND

COG is a regional organization comprising of 19 local governments surrounding our nation's capital, plus area members of the Maryland and Virginia legislatures, the U.S. Senate, and the U.S. House of Representatives. It provides a focus for action and develops sound regional responses to such issues as the environment, affordable housing, economic development, health and family concerns, human services, population growth, public safety, and transportation.

Founded in 1957, COG is an independent, nonprofit association. It is supported by financial contributions from its participating local governments, federal and state grants and contracts, and donations from foundations and the private sector.

Membership

COG has more than 250 members, including the governing officials of COG's participating governments, plus Maryland, Virginia, and congressional legislators for districts in the metropolitan Washington area.

The following local governments participate in COG: the District of Columbia; Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William counties and the cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Manassas, and Manassas Park in Virginia; Frederick, Montgomery, and Prince George's counties and the cities of Bowie, College Park, Gaithersburg, Greenbelt, Rockville, and Takoma Park in Maryland.

COG operates under policies established by the membership through its Board of Directors, which meets monthly to address issues of regional concern.

POLICY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES

COG policies and programs are developed under the direction and guidance of the following Boards and Committees: the COG Board of Directors, the Transportation Planning Board, the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee, the Metropolitan Development Policy Committee, the Human Services Policy Committee, the Public Safety Policy Committee, the Committee on Noise Abatement and Aviation at National and Dulles Airports, and the Chesapeake Bay Policy Committee.

Membership on these policy committees includes elected officials appointed by each of the 19 participating governments. In some cases, representatives from the Maryland and Virginia General Assemblies; federal, state, and regional agencies; citizens groups; and various private sector organizations are represented. All Board and Committee meetings are open to the public.

Transportation Planning Board (TPB)

The National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board was created in 1965 by a Memorandum of Agreement among local governments and the state departments of transportation of the Washington area in response to the requirements of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1962. In July 1966, by mutual agreement, the TPB became associated with COG as its Transportation Policy Committee. In consultation with its technical committee, the TPB is responsible for developing regional transportation policy and a long-range transportation plan for the National Capital Region. The Board includes representatives of the transportation agencies of the states of Maryland, Virginia, and the District of Columbia, local governments, the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, the Maryland and Virginia General Assemblies, and a non-voting member from the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority and federal agencies. **The TPB meets at noon on the third Wednesday of every month, except August.** To confirm meeting dates and times, contact Ronald F. METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON AIR QUALITY COMMITTEE

The Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) is the entity certified by the mayor of the District of Columbia and the governors of Maryland and Virginia to prepare an air quality plan for the DC-MD-VA Metropolitan Statistical Area, under Section 174 of the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990. Membership of MWAQC consists of elected officials of COG member jurisdictions, plus members from Charles, Calvert, and Stafford counties¹; the air management and transportation directors of the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia; members of the Maryland and Virginia General Assemblies; and the chair of the Transportation Planning Board. In executing its responsibilities, MWAQC coordinates air quality planning activities among COG and other external committees and the Transportation Planning Board, reviews policies, resolves policy differences, and adopts a regional air quality plan for transmittal to the District of Columbia and the states of Maryland and Virginia. **MWAQC meets at noon on the fourth Wednesday of every month, except August.** To confirm meeting dates and times, contact Joan Rohlf, chief of Air Quality Planning, at (202) 962-3358.

Clean Air Partners

Clean Air Partners is a volunteer, nonprofit, public-private consortium chartered by COG and the Baltimore Metropolitan Council in 1994. It is the air quality, public education campaign for ground-level ozone serving the Washington and Baltimore metropolitan regions. The Partnership seeks to improve health and the quality of life in the region by educating the public to take voluntary action to reduce ground-level ozone and to reduce exposure to ozone. Ground-level ozone is the only one of six criteria air pollutants for which the region has not attained the EPA's health-based standards. Clean Air Partners has member-partner organizations from across the two regions – representatives of government, private sector, and advocacy organizations. The Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments and the Baltimore Metropolitan Council actively support the Partners' efforts, with COG providing administrative and financial support.

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The District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (DC WASA) operates the award-winning Blue Plains wastewater treatment facility, the world's largest advanced wastewater treatment plant. For half a century, this agency, now an Authority, has distributed drinking water, read meters, and collected and treated wastewater while protecting the environment. On October 1, 1996, the Authority became an independent agency of the District of Columbia government. Funding for operations, improvements, and debt financing comes through usage fees, the sale of revenue bonds, and grants.

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The Greater Washington Board of Trade is the largest regional network of business and nonprofit leaders, and the only group representing all industry sectors. The Board of Trade's 1,200 member companies employ 40 percent of Greater Washington's private sector workforce. Organizations join the Board of Trade to grow their business and help build a better community.

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INTERSTATE COMMISSION ON THE POTOMAC RIVER BASIN

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The Commission promotes conserving, protecting, and improving the quality of waters and associated land resources of the Potomac Valley Conservancy District. It provides for maximum enjoyment and use, including water supply, adequately treated waste effluents disposition, fish and wildlife propagation, industrial and agricultural development, gainful employment, and maintaining a high quality environment.

Established in 1940, the Commission operates under an amended compact of September 1970 (P.L. 91-407). The states of Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and West Virginia, the District of Columbia, and the president of the United States appoint members. The annual meeting for elections is held each September. Business meetings occur in March, June, September, and December.

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A bi-county agency created by the Maryland General Assembly in 1927, M-NCPPC has physical planning jurisdiction over the major portion of Montgomery and Prince George's counties. The Commission also acquires, develops, operates, and maintains a regional park system in both counties.

In Prince George's County, the Commission conducts the public recreation program. Members are appointed by Montgomery and Prince George's County governments. Members from each county constitute Planning Boards that meet separately on Thursdays, except in August. The two Planning Boards join as the Commission to meet on the third Wednesday of each month, except August.

Commissioners are appointed for 4-year terms; new appointments are made 4 years from the date the respective Commissioner was sworn in.

METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON AIRPORTS AUTHORITY

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The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority assumed responsibility for managing, operating, maintaining, and improving Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington Dulles International Airports on June 7, 1987. Until then, the Federal Aviation Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation had been operating both airports. A 50-year lease of the airports affected the transfer. In June 2003, the lease was extended for an additional 30 years.

The Authority is staffed by approximately 1,300 employees and is governed by a Board of Directors with three members appointed by the Mayor of the District of Columbia, two by the Governor of Maryland, five by the Governor of Virginia and three by the President of the United States. The Authority's Board of Directors normally meets the first Wednesday of each month.

Its functions also include: preparing an annual six-year Federal Capital Improvements Program for the National Capital Region; reviewing proposed federal and District government installation master plans and project plans; and reviewing proposed local, state, and regional policies, plans, and programs, including proposed rezoning and site plan applications that might have some impact on federal lands or interests in the region.
