    - Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
  - Providing freight information and highlighting freight issues to the TPB
  - Provides opportunities to exchange information and examine regional-level issues

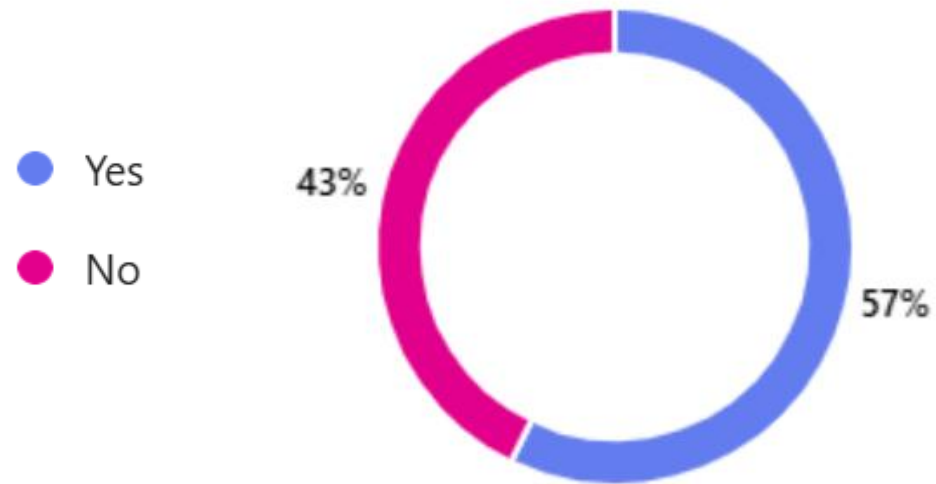

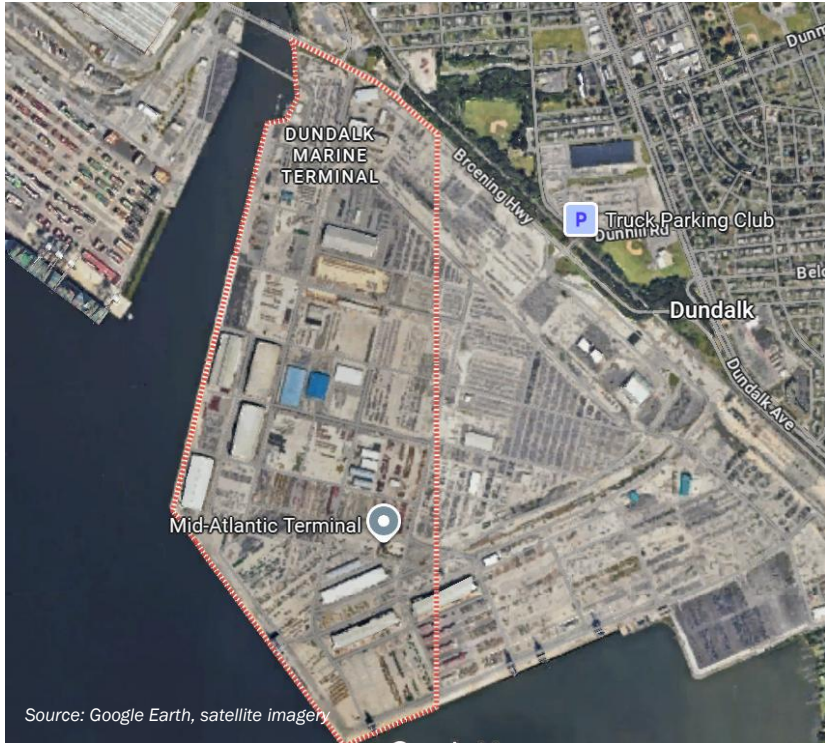
