This plan provides the framework for local jurisdictions and transit agencies to support resource sharing, including supplies, vehicles, equipment, and personnel during a crisis or planned event. Coordination is supported year-round through a regional Mutual Aid Agreement (MAA) that serves as the policy bedrock for all regional, inter- and intrastate mutual aid plans. All transportation agencies in the National Capital Region are strongly encouraged to become signatories to the MAA and the TMAOP.
