

PRIDE 365 FUND

Facilitated by the Capital Pride Alliance, the Pride 365 Fund awards financial resources to 501(c)(3) organizations that demonstrate a commitment to the LGBTQ+ community 365 days a year.

- A portion of sponsorship and event partner revenue will be directed to the Pride 365 Fund.
- Funding Priorities:
 - The New LGBTQ+ Community Center
 - Sibling Prides (AAPI Pride, DC Black Pride, DC Latinx Pride, Trans Pride Washington, DC, Silver Pride, Youth Pride)
 - First-time Parade and Festival participating non-profit organizations.
 - Services and resources that promote collaboration among LGBTQ+ organizations.
 - Establishment of a LGBTQ+ Burial Fund






WHAT WE'VE DONE

- Between FY24 and FY25, DDC has invested +\$3.5 million on domestic and international paid media to directly promote WorldPride.
- Examples include custom content pieces, OOH, activations, digital advertising and more.


DDC'S WORLDPRIDE INVESTMENT

DDC'S WORLDPRIDE INVESTMENT




Bookings over major WorldPride weeks are currently pacing ahead of last year by about 9%.

Bookings are expected to pick up in mid to late April as **booking** windows shorten.


