WHEREAS, COG's Child welfare program coordinates foster parent recruitment efforts throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, COG Child Welfare staff also supports the Wednesday's Child program on NBC Channel 4 news, which brings awareness of the teenagers, sibling groups, and medically fragile children who are waiting to be adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Morris and Gwendolyn Cafritz Foundation is committed to building a stronger community for residents of the Washington, DC metropolitan area through support of programs in the arts and humanities, community services, education, health and the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COG BOARD OF DIRECTORS THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to seek funds in the amount of \$50,000 from the Morris and Gwendolyn Cafritz Foundation to support COG Child Welfare, Foster Care and Wednesday's Child programs. Additional funds to support this activity are included in the adopted FY2016 Work Program and Budget.
