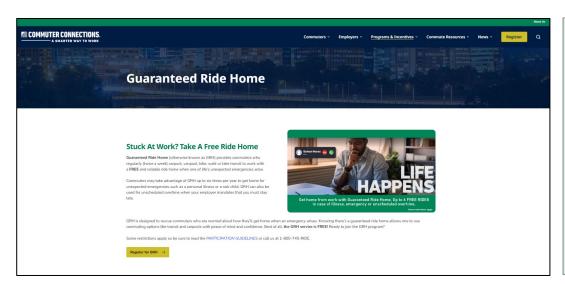

### **GRH Program Requirements and Registration**

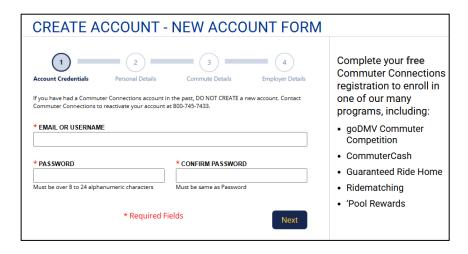
- Six (6) free rides home from work per year by taxi/ridehail, transit, or rental car
- Must commute by non-SOV mode at least twice per week
- Acceptable uses: personal illness, family/childcare emergency, carpool/vanpool emergency, and unexpected overtime
- Available Mon-Fri, 6am-10pm (no weekends or holidays)

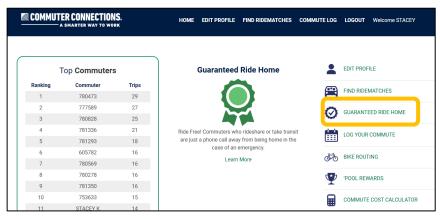




## **GRH Program Requirements and Registration**

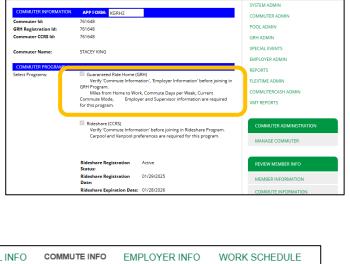
- Registration options:

  - Log into existing account and select Guaranteed Ride Home from the menu





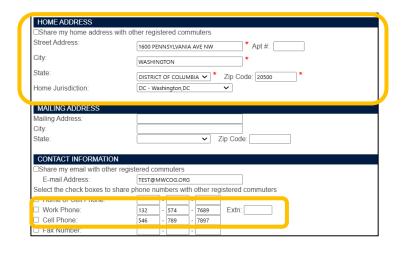
## Managing Registrations in TDM System

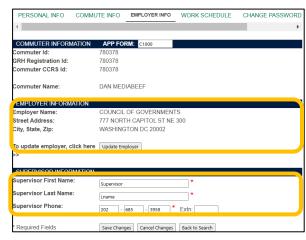
- Review participant's account for:
  - Home address and 2 phone numbers
  - Work address, schedule, supervisor's name and contact
  - Select a non-SOV mode at least 2 days per week
- If any required information is missing follow up with applicant

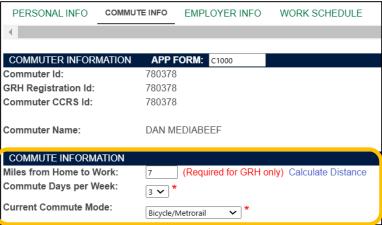

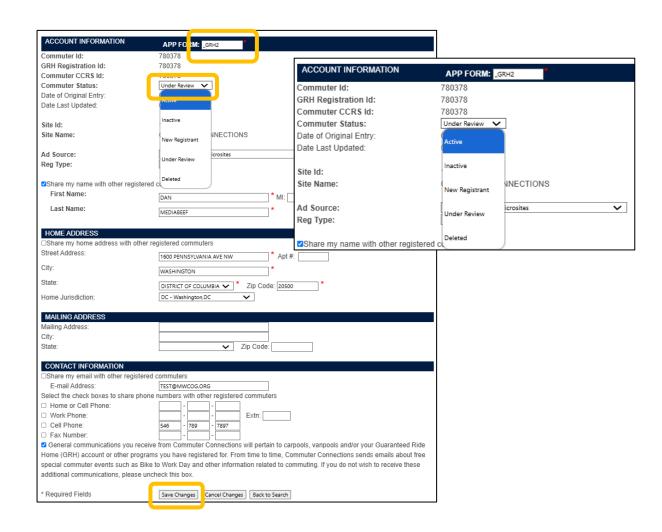






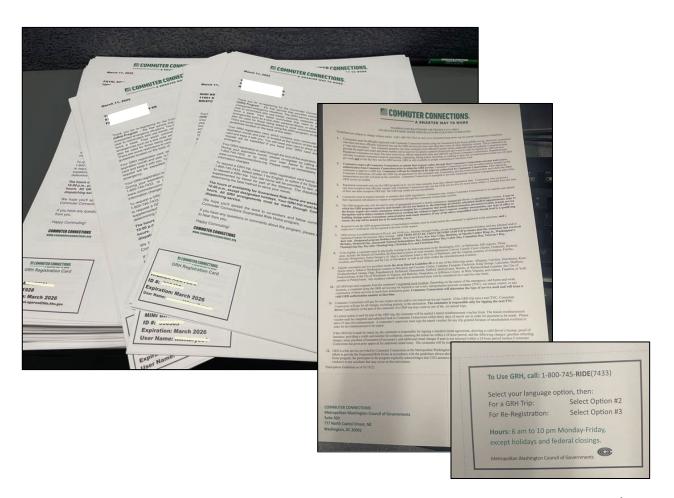
# Managing Registrations in TDM System

- Remember to save changes!



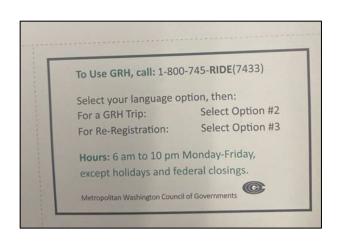
### Participant Experience – What Happens Next?

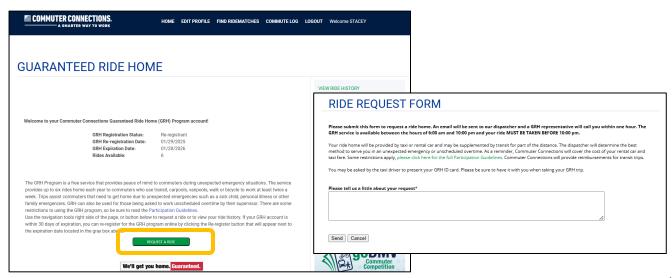
- Commuter Connections

- Participants receive a letter and GRH Registration Card from Commuter Connections 1-2 weeks after registering or re-registering.



#### Participant Experience – Using GRH

- To request a ride, participants may:
  - Call 1-800-745-RIDE (7433) OR
  - Log in to their account, select GRH, and Request a Ride
- Dispatch will arrange for ride (must be requested and taken before 10pm)
- Participant receives a survey by email the day after the GRH request
