1. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR SUBMISSION OF NORTHERN VIRGINIA PROJECTS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA'S SMART SCALE TRANSPORTATION PROJECT PRIORITIZATION PROCESS

Localities, agencies and public transportation providers that wish to submit for projects for funding through the Commonwealth of Virginia's SMART SCALE prioritization process must demonstrate that the project is included in or is consistent with the MPO's metropolitan transportation plan, and, the project must have an MPO resolution of support, in order to be considered for the SMART SCALE prioritization process. A list of projects have been identified and are seeking assistance to be able to submit SMART SCALE applications, due August 1, 2026.

Action: Adopt Resolution SR32-2026 to support submission of the Virginia list of SMART SCALE projects.

2. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF TWO RESOLUTIONS TO AMEND THE FY 2026-2029 TIP THAT MEET OR ARE EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT

Actions:

- Adopt TPB SR33-2026 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 26-10.1 (DDOT STIP), which adds funding and reactivates the Georgia Avenue NW multimodal access improvements project and adds funding to the Anacostia River pedestrian and bike connectivity project as requested by DDOT.
- Adopt TPB SR34-2026 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 26-10.1 (DDOT STIP), which adds funding to six project groupings for bus, bus facilities, and paratransit, operations and business support, railcar and rail facilities, rail systems, station and passenger facilities, and track and structures rehabilitation as requested by WMATA.
