



2 replacement buses to provide training, integration, employment, day support and transportation for persons with disabilities.

- **Geographic Focus:** Fairfax and Loudoun Counties
- **Federal Total:** \$246,484

Opportunities, Inc.

Offer travel training, hire Direct Service Professionals for one-on-one travel training, host training session for professionals.

Coach Transportation, Inc. DBA Koach

Deliver quality paratransit service with focus on underserved populations, hire/train drivers with WAVs, and increase fleet of WAVs.

- **Geographic Focus:** Prince George's County and Washington, DC
- **Federal Total:** \$715,000



Yellow Transportation, LLC.

Replace WAV vehicles in fleet and enhance transportation services for older adults and persons with disabilities.

- **Geographic Focus:** Washington DC Region
- **Federal Total:** \$333,500

Projects Recommended For Funding

Construction/Transit Infrastructure – Highlighted Project

Montgomery County Department of Transportation

Improve physical infrastructure of multiple bus stops that serve communities with high percentage of older adults and persons with disabilities.

- **Geographic Focus:** Montgomery County
- **Federal Total:** \$387,450



Projects Not Recommended For Funding

- Six applications were not recommended for funding. The rationale for not funding these applications include:
 - Lack of coordination prioritized in the Coordinated Plan.
 - Marginal impacts to the underserved populations of the region compared to other projects.
 - Lack of financial capability to match the federal funds available.
- Denied applicants will receive communication with recommendations for improving their application for the next grant solicitation and will also be offered a debriefing about their application with TPB staff.


