TPB actions March 18, 2026

- **Adopt Resolution R11-2026**

Action to amend the 2026 UPWP to remove funding to be “carried over” to FY 2027 and to approve “carryover” funding from FY 2026 to FY 2027

- **Adopt Resolution R12-2026**

Action to approve FY 2027 UPWP



Carry Over and FY 2025 Amendment

- The total FY 2027 revenue comes from 3 “buckets” of funding through the state DOTs:
 - “New” fiscal year FY 2027 funding
 - “Old” funding from last year’s UPWP (FY 2025) – obligated to the MPO but not spent (called “unexpended”)
 - “Carryover” funding from current year UPWP (FY 2026) that we anticipate not being able to spend by June 30, 2026
- Carry over \$2,680,000 from Tasks 1, 3, 4, 5, 7
- Total Amended FY 2026 UPWP \$24,559,546
- Total FY 2027 UPWP \$28,934,813



Next steps after TPB action

- Submit FY 2027 UPWP to U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT)
- U.S. DOT takes 60 days to approve
- Receive funding authorization from DDOT, MDOT, VDOT, and VDRPT
- Start work on July 1!
