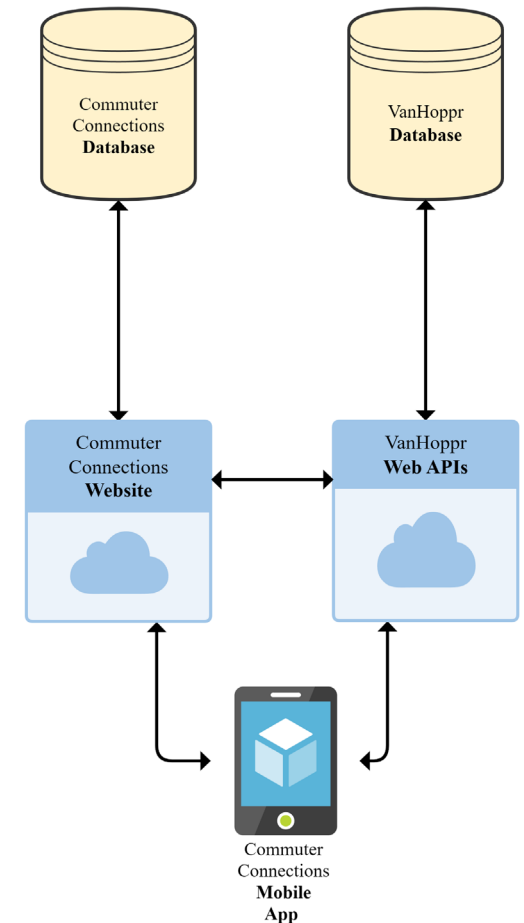

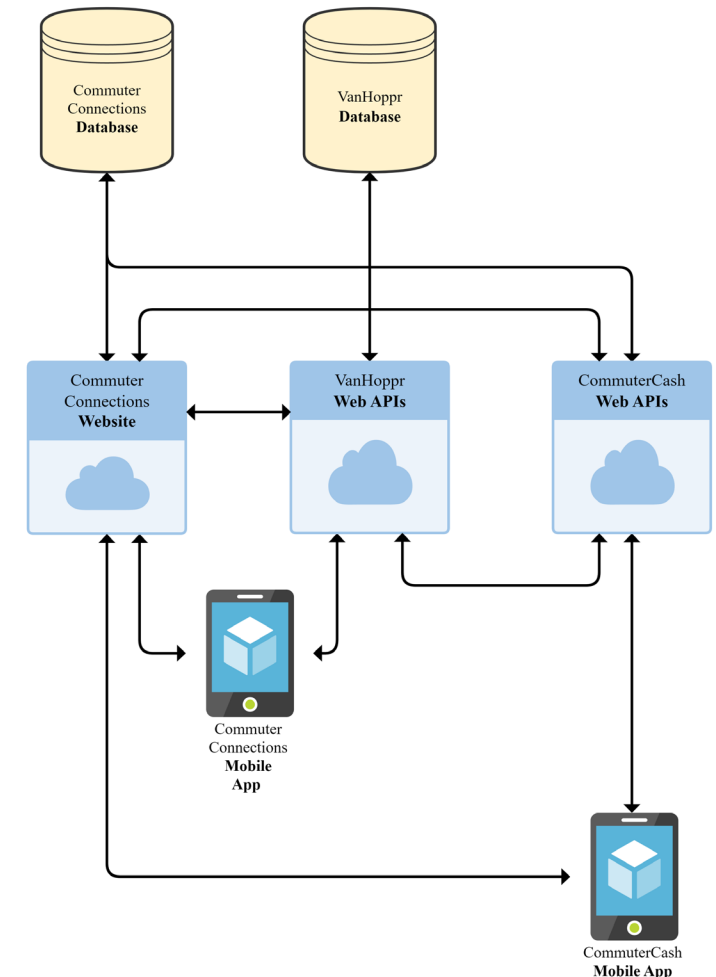
Overview – Current Architecture

- Two sets of Web APIs to operate
- VanHoppr APIs have some functionality that communicate directly with the TDM website (when adding or updating drivers via the admin website)
- Login, core ridematching, trip logging, and GRH use APIs running from the main Commuter Connections website
- Vanpool match results, one-time ride costs, push alerts, vanpool driver features are powered by the VanHoppr APIs



Overview – Proposed Architecture

- Adding a third API set with increased functionality
- Intention is to not duplicate any functionality built to date but rather augment and extend database tables and functionality within existing TDM database
- New codebase will work in tandem and communicate heavily with existing TDM and VanHoppr APIs
- Code to be written in JAVA Spring Boot



Phase 1 – Core Functionality

Pre-Production (Phase 1) – COMPLETE

- ✓ Application research and prototyping.
- ✓ Prepare wireframes, mobile application designs

Production (Phase 1) – 80% COMPLETE as of 12/17/24

- ✓ Trip Planner
- ✓ Commute Log
- ✓ Gamification Dashboard
- ✓ Rewards / Point Redemption
- ☐ Forgot Password (PENDING, along with other account editing capabilities)

Phase 1 – Core Functionality

Technical Notes

- Build new HTML/JS web framework mobile application utilizing code from both existing CCMobile and incenTrip mobile applications.
- New application to be cross-platform and not platform dependent so there will be a single codebase for both iOS and Android to minimize development time and updates.
- Develop new database schema and JAVA/Spring API to support the new mobile application on the backend

Phase 2 – goDMV & Administrator Functionality

Phase 2 – goDMV & Administrator Functionality

Milestones

- Soft launch the updated mobile application by January 15, 2025
- Hard launch by February 1, 2025.

Phase 3 – Advanced Features

End-user Functionality

- ☐ Multimodal trip planning options (Drive to Rail, Drive to Park and Ride Stop)
- ☐ Corridor Challenges
- ☐ Flextime Rewards
- ☐ Programmable Bonuses
- ☐ Reach A Ride (customizable popup in dashboard)

Milestones

- Soft launch the updated mobile application by May 15, 2025
- Hard launch by June 1, 2025.
