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# **Technical Assistance Program Overview**

- The program is unique to TPB and is not federally mandated
- Assists state and local governments as well as transit operating agencies with projects that advance metropolitan planning, including regional goals, priorities, and aspirations
- Applies TPB-developed tools, techniques, data, and staff capabilities
- Projects vary from pre-planning studies to travel modeling to data collection across metropolitan Washington
- Occasionally consultants are hired to support projects if special expertise or additional capacity is needed



# **Overview: 4 General Project Categories**

### 1. Assisting state and local agencies in preplanning analyses

- Montgomery County, working with the Maryland State Highway Administration, requested support in analyzing feasibility of BRT
- Virginia Park and Ride study

#### 2. Internal data gathering

- I-95/I-395 HOV counts
- Non-motorized counts in the District of Columbia and Virginia

# 3. Studies that can help inform larger regional interests

- Commuter Bus Parking Study
- Regional Bus Service Provision Study
- MARC-VRE Run Through Service Study
- 4. Augmenting funding availability for TPB local technical assistance grant programs
  - Transportation Land-Use Connections (TLC)
  - Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP)
  - Transit Within Reach (TWR)



### **How is the Program Funded**

- Funding is based upon an agreed-upon percentage of the total new FTA and FHWA planning funding passed through each state into TPB Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).
- \$1.6 million total FY 2026 Technical Assistance Budget
  - \$303,000 District of Columbia
  - \$538,000 Maryland
  - \$473,000 Virginia
  - \$275,000 Regional Transit
