

Key Features: Account Creation

- Download CommuterCash from the App Store or Google Play
- Login with your existing Commuter Connections account OR tap Create Account button to set up your account and login
 - Previous incenTrip participants use same login credentials
- Forgot login/inactive accounts? Contact Commuter Connections






Key Features: Account Creation

- Screens:
 - Home Screen (currently displays goDMV leaderboard)
 - Log Trip
 - Trip Planner
 - Rewards

Menu (top left) helps navigate to other functions





Key Features: Trip Explorer

- Adjust search criteria to display options
- Select a mode for more information
 - Carpool: displays Commuter
 Connections ridematch results
 - Transit, Biking, and Driving: display Google/Transit API-based results
- Select an option for map view (Map) or directions (List)









Key Features: Tracking Trips

- Select your mode and destination
 - Pre-populated work/home buttons
 OR select Enter New Address for a new destination
- Point Eligibility Checklist visual indicators that trip will be awarded points
- Press Start Trip button
- You're on your way!









Key Features: Tracking Trips

- Trips should end automatically when you enter the geofence of the destination – look for the banner notification on your phone!
- If trip doesn't automatically end, or you need to end the trip before reaching the intended destination, tap the End Trip button
- View your Trip History for confirmation of the completed trip and points awarded







Key Features: Redeeming Points

- Tap the Rewards icon to see your rewards
- Amounts increase as you progress through rewards tiers
- Select the reward you want to redeem and enter the appropriate account information
- Tap the Rewards History link to view all your rewards redemptions
- Current Rewards Tiers:

goDMV Overview

- Friendly competition among DMV employers that encourages behavior change through competition and gamification
- Three different leaderboards: (1) Large Employer;
 (2) Small Employer; (3) Individual Commuter
 - Up to six non-SOV trip logs per day for an individual commuter will count as points toward leaderboards
- Points will be added to the commuter's respective employer team, and as the individual leaderboard
- Leaderboard positions will determine grand prizes at the conclusion of the competition
