Regional Public Transportation Subcommittee: On June 23, the Regional Public Transportation Subcommittee met virtually and discussed transit-oriented development, previewed TPB's bike and pedestrian plan, and regional extreme heat resilience analysis and toolkit. The City of Alexandria presented an update of its Duke Street in Motion project plus other transit-oriented and bus priority projects under development. Then TPB staff presented an update of the draft National Capital Region Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan and both the findings and content of the Regional Transportation Resilience Extreme Heat Analysis and Toolkit for transportation planning, with a focus on transit. RPTS will next meet on July 28 in-person.

Mobility Analytics Subcommittee: On June 25, the Mobility Analytics Subcommittee met to discuss Virginia Railway Express's (VRE) updates outlook on ridership demand through 2040, TPB's Congestion Management Process, and TPB's Mobility Analytics Program. The meeting started with VRE's 2040 demand remodeling process, reflecting current commuting patterns and regional growth trends, informing corridor-level and system-wide planning decisions. Then, TPB staff shared an update on TPB's Congestion Management Process and received feedback from members. Lastly, TPB staff provided an update on the Mobility Analytics Program, sharing upcoming processes and deadlines. Members of the subcommittee then shared updates with each other on challenges and opportunities that they are experiencing in travel monitoring data analytics from within their respective organizations, in a round-table format.
