Mr. Edwards and Ms. Waller will discuss Montgomery County's Comprehensive Flood Management Plan (CFMP). The CFMP is a multiyear effort to improve County's ability to mitigate and adapt to flooding. Mr. Edwards and Ms. Waller will touch on updated climate (precipitation) scenarios that are being used in the County's modeling effort and a technical memo related to projected increases in impervious areas that are factored into the modeling.

The Potomac River Tunnel (PRT) is the next major phase of the DC Clean Rivers Project.

The project consists of a large-diameter deep sewer tunnel, diversion facilities, drop shafts, and support structures to capture flows from existing combined sewer overflows (CSOs) along the Potomac River and convey them to the Blue Plains Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant for treatment.
