## Financial Plan Requirement and Work Plan

#### **Financial Plan Requirement**

- Federal planning regulations (§450.324(f)(11)) require a financial plan that demonstrates how the adopted long-range transportation plan can be implemented.
- Forecast year-of-expenditure (YOE) revenues that are reasonably expected to be available must cover the estimated YOE costs of maintaining, operating, and expanding the highway and transit system.


#### **Work Plan**

- The financial analysis work plan has two components. Firstly, high-level "top-down" projections
  of revenue and expenditures (by type) are provided by the funding agencies. Secondly, a
  "bottom-up" review of project costs in the Project Info Track (PIT) database is conducted. The
  two are reconciled to produce the analysis results.
- Work on the financial analysis began in 2023 to inform the submission of the regionally significant for air quality (RSAQ) projects in December 2023.



## Regional Revenues: Visualize 2050


(2026-2050; Billions, in Year of Expenditure \$)





## Regional Revenues Breakdown: Visualize 2050


(2026-2050; Billions, in Year of Expenditure \$)
