

Meeting Highlights TPB Technical Committee – July 1, 2026

The following items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB's June agenda:

FY 2027 MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET ASIDE PROGRAM PROJECT APPROVALS

The committee received a briefing on recommended projects for the federal Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TAP) in suburban Maryland. The TPB will be asked to approve them at its upcoming July 15 meeting.

PERFORMANCE MEASURES AND TARGETS: ON-ROAD VOC AND NOX EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS FROM CMAQ-FUNDED PROJECT

The committee received a briefing on two performance measures and proposed targets for on-road emissions reductions for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) and for Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) from congestion mitigation and air quality (CMAQ) funded projects, including data, performance, and forecasting methodologies. The TPB will be asked to adopt the FY 2026-2029 targets that were presented last month at its upcoming July 15 meeting.

DMVMOVES SERVICE GUIDELINES

The committee received a briefing on the work of the DMVMoves working group developing a regional set of service guidelines and performance measures for public transportation. Following a recommendation of the DMVMoves Plan adopted in November 2025 and endorsed by the TPB in January 2026, the TPB will be asked to adopt the set of regional service guidelines in September.

2025 STATE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION REPORT

The committee received a briefing on the 2025 Annual State of Public Transportation report. The purpose of this report was to provide a concise overview of the state of regional public transportation in the National Capital Region.

The following items were presented for information and discussion:

2015 NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS FOR OZONE: REDESIGNATION REQUEST AND MAINTENANCE PLAN, BRIEFING ON ON-ROAD EMISSIONS INVENTORIES

The committee received a briefing on the proposed values of motor vehicle emissions budgets in the draft 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards Maintenance Plan. Also, the committee was made aware of the upcoming public comment period for the Maintenance Plan and Redesignation Request.

PROJECT INFOTRAK USER GUIDE & TIP/STIP WORKFLOW

The committee received a briefing on the Project InfoTrak User Guide and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)/State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Workflow.

NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PLAN UPDATE

The committee received a briefing on plans for updating the National Capital Region Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, last updated in 2022.

ALEXMOVES: BI-ANNUAL RESIDENT TRANSPORTATION SURVEY

The committee received a briefing on the results of their latest bi-annual resident transportation survey AlexMoves.
