

## Meeting Highlights TPB Technical Committee – June 5, 2026

The following items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB's June agenda:

### **VDOT SECTION OF THE TIP AMENDMENT**

The committee received a briefing on VDOT's amendment update of all project and funding information in its portion of the FY 2026-2029 TIP to align with its Draft FY 2027-2030 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The board will be asked to approve the VDOT FY 2026-2029 TIP amendment at its June 17 meeting.

### **APPROVE PHED AND NON-SOV TARGETS**

The committee received a briefing on the two performance measures, peak hours of excessive delay per capita and percentage non-SOV mode share, including data, performance, and forecasting methodologies. The committee was also briefed on the proposed targets for CY 2026-2029. The board will be asked to adopt the targets at its June 17 meeting.

### **PERFORMANCE MEASURES AND TARGETS: DRAFT VOC AND NOX TARGETS**

The committee received a briefing on two performance measures, emissions reductions for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) and for Nitrogen Oxides (NOx), that relate to TPB's goals for air quality. The collected data, explanations, methodological applications for target-setting for FY 2026-2029, and next steps were shared.

### **EXTREME HEAT ANALYSIS OVERVIEW**

The committee received a briefing on the recently completed extreme heat analysis, a project intended to analyze and provide guidance on a variety of heat-related issues to inform strategies to enhance the resilience and adaptive capacity of the region's multimodal transportation network.

### **TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT UPDATE**

The committee received a briefing on recent developments in Traffic Incident Management (TIM) by State DOTs and other organizations, continuing the recommendations of the Traffic Incident Management (TIM) Enhancement Task Force in 2018.
