

The Virginia excise tax on gasoline is \$0.175 per gallon






Alternative fuels are subject to the same tax rate, with rare exceptions



AFV Job Creation Tax Credit






E85 in Virginia-Maryland-DC

- Objective: Use grants to encourage fuel distributors to provide 12 new public E85 dispensers for use by up to 15,000 private and government Flex Fuel Vehicles
- Financing: \$767,000
 - \$284,000 -- US Energy Department grant
 - \$200,000 -- Virginia and Maryland state funds
 - \$283,000 -- Fuel distributors




